



Who is GFAN?

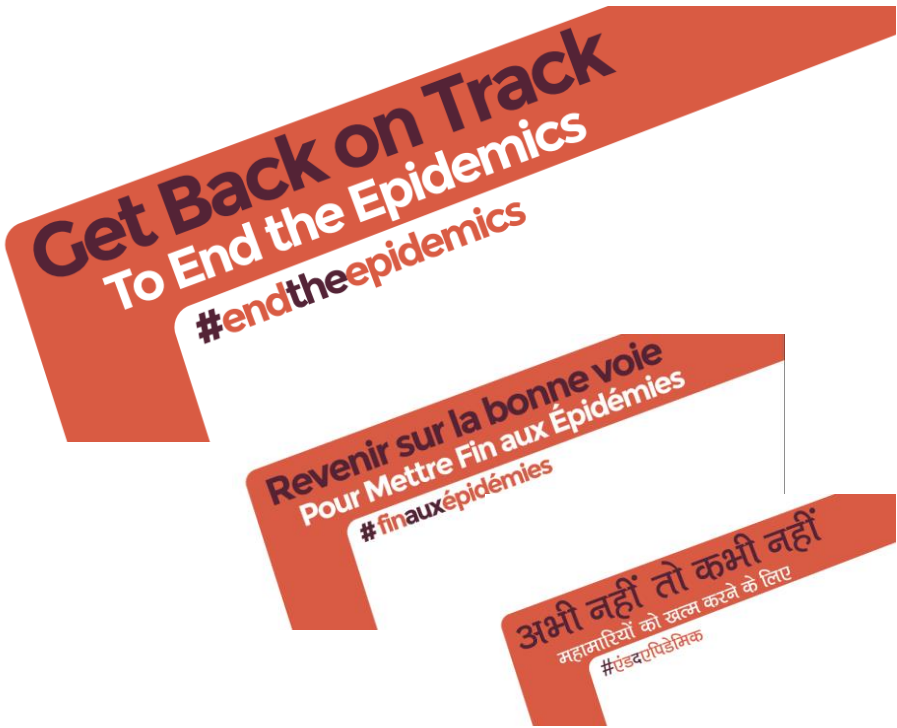
- Established in 2011 to unite voices and efforts from activists and advocates all over the world to support a fully funded and effective Global Fund
