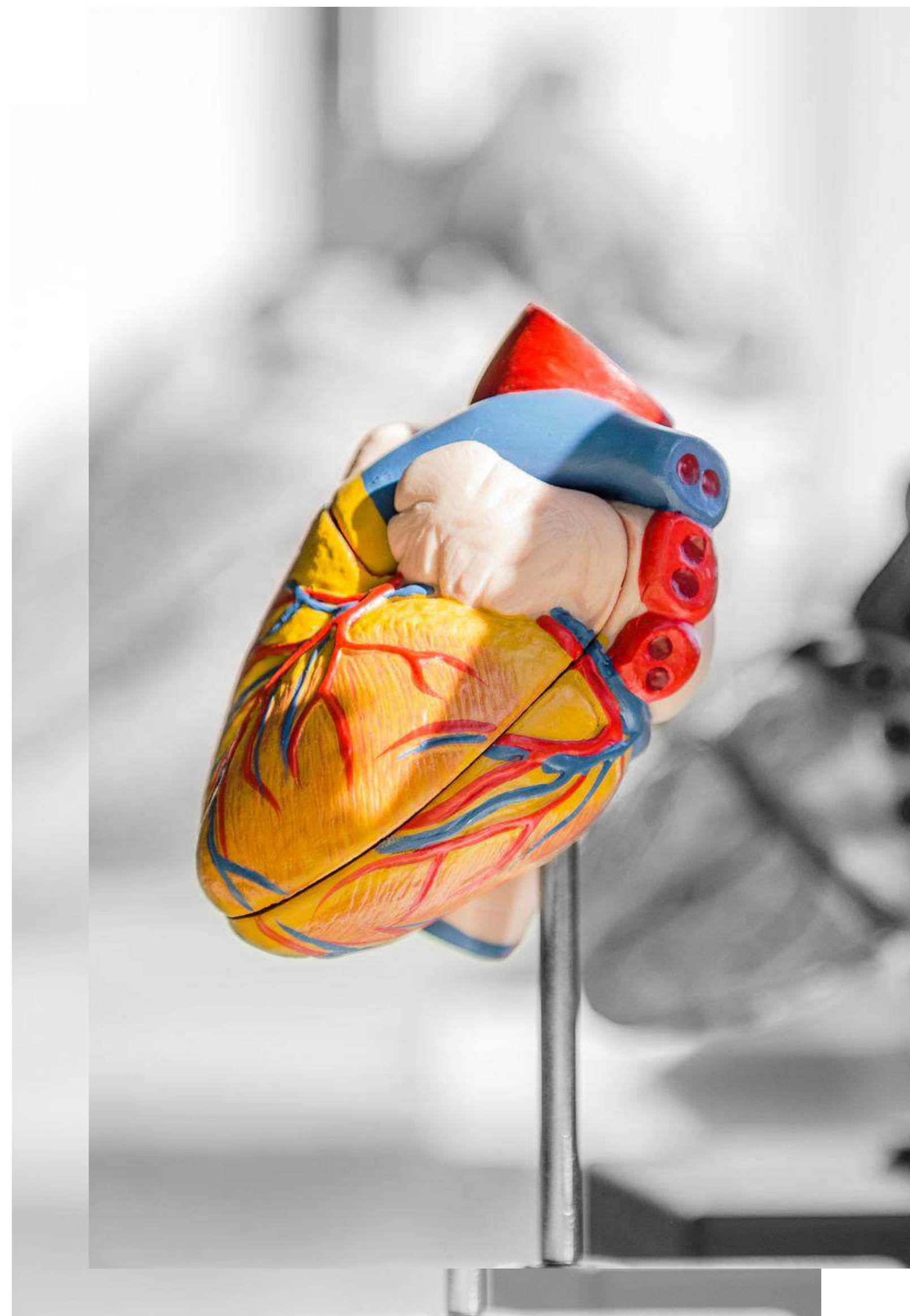
# GF INVESTMENTS

CIVIL SOCIETY*

The GF investments in Indonesia continues to aid communities and civil society in the fight against HIV, TB, and Malaria through:

- Provisions of vital logistics and non-pharmaceutical supplies/ equipments
- Provisions of TA and capacity building activities (e.g., health literacy, legal literacy, and advocacy skills)
- Sensitization of lawmakers, law enforcement agents, health workers, and other vital figures to achieve health equity
- Increase of meaningful engagement of communities and civil society in CCM and other platforms
- Engagement of underrepresented, vulnerable and marginalized groups, such as women, youths, and KP
- Intensive support to remove human rights barrier to access HIV and TB services
