## Community key asks so far

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# TB

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- Clear, measurable targets on diagnosing and treating people with TB
- Commitments that explicitly support the human rights of people affected by TB
- Accelerate the research, development, roll-out and access to new TB vaccines, diagnostics, drugs and other essential tools
- The inclusion of clear financial targets for TB response and for research
- Provisions for an accountability framework

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# PPPR

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- Proper coordination mechanism be created as soon as possible to allow for equal CSO and community inputs to the PPR discussions
- Commitments in the declaration recognising the role of community leadership and representation
- Language in the declaration that would commit to equity in PPPR and also commit to actions to achieve this
- declaration would commit to building on the existing infrastructure and expertise in the responses to HIV, TB, and other diseases

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# CSEM



- Political leadership and governance - Commit to repeal existing harmful laws that continue to criminalize and marginalize the poorest and most vulnerable populations
- Service coverage - Emphasize the need to meaningfully engage with communities in the design process of innovations to build trust and acceptance among the populations they are intended to reach
- Sustainable Financing- Specifically commit to increasing and sustaining health spending ideally at least 5% of GDP or more
- Health Workforce - Explicitly state that health workers including community health workers will be prioritized and protected during health emergencies
- Health Emergency Preparedness- Integrate mental health, rehabilitation, and assistive technology as part of PHC
- Monitoring, Accountability and Multi-Stakeholder Engagement- Emphasize the need for timely and transparent sharing of information particularly in times of emergency

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# APCASO

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- Strengthen community systems for health
- Promote allocative efficiency, innovative financing, and domestic resource mobilization
- Integration of mental health services.
- Enhance equity in UHC.
- Establish inclusive and participative governance for UHC
